

AUTHORISATION TO ESTABLISH PREMISES AS AN INSPECTION STATION

Pursuant to Regulations 3A(1)(b), 3A(2) and 3C(2) of the *Road Traffic (Licensing) Regulations 1975*, I, **Allan Jenner**, as **A/Manager Approved Inspection Stations**, and delegate of the Director General of the

Department of Transport (Transport), hereby authorise **Pebco Contracting Services Pty Ltd Trading As Pebco Automotive Service** ("the Authorised Person") to establish premises at **Lot 4 Marryat Court**, **Hamilton Hill** as an Authorised Inspection Station examining and testing vehicles for licensing purposes, subject to the conditions set out below.

CONDITIONS

- 1. The Authorised Person must only allow the premises to be used for inspecting:
 - a) Cars, station sedans, four wheel drives, utilities, panel vans, mobile caravans (campervans) and other light commercial vehicles with a Gross Vehicle Mass not exceeding 4.5 tonne;
 - b) Caravans and trailers with an Aggregate Trailer Mass not exceeding 4.5 tonne; and
 - c) Motorcycles, mopeds and scooters.
- 2. The Authorised Person must only allow the premises to be used for the following inspections:
 - a) vehicles issued with a defect notice (Work Order);
 - b) new vehicles (not previously licensed);
 - vehicles imported from other Australian states, The Northern Territory and the Australian Capital Territory;
 - d) vehicles that have had their WA licence lapse;
 - e) modified vehicles
 - f) vehicles requiring minor correction of their licence details;
 - g) vehicles that have been repaired and inspected by an Approved Written-Off Vehicle
 AIS after being registered on the Written-Off Vehicles Register;
 - vehicles require re-examining after failing any of the above inspections;
 - i) Vehicles that requires an annual inspection e.g. Taxi, Small Charter Vehicle, Omnibus, Driving School Vehicle;
