Worked at BP Willagee service station for 15/months then travelled overseas for three years working in UK, USA & Canada.

Back to WA working in Service stations at Alfred Cove, Willagee & Victoria Park (same owner)

Three years working for Wynn's Australia as a commercial sales Rep (commission only) during that time started Pebco in my back yard and then started full time in Myaree in 1981.

- 1981 - current Established Pebco Automotive in 1981 in Myaree. In 1990 we bought a property in Hamilton Hill, where we still run and operate this business today, covering all aspects of automotive mechanical and electrical repair. Department of Transport authorised inspection station.
- 1984 - 1991 A founding member of the Bosch EFI group WA where I was on the committee for the full time it was operating and held the position of Chairperson for the last four years before expanding to **BASDN(Bosch Au tomotive Service Dealer Network) of Western Australia.**
- 1991 - 2008 A founding member of the new BASDN where I was on the committee for ten years holding positions of Vice Chair then Chairperson for four years, back to Vice for a year, then Chairperson again for another two years before stepping down in 2008.
During this time I spent five years as a National Director for **BASDN Australasia**
- 1982 - current Member of the Motor Trade Association.
- 1996 – current Held various positions on the Motor Trade Association Automotive Repairers Division including the Chairperson for a period of 6 years.
- 2001 - current Currently on the Board of Management for the Motor Trade Association and have been President for over 6 years.
- 2008 – current Director on the Motor Trades Association of Australia Board and became a Director on the MTAA House Trustee in 2011.

Held a position on the Automotive Training Australia Board for 3 years.
